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MISSOURI Home and Community-Based Services Settings Rule Corrective Action Plan Request

Missouri received final approval of the Statewide transition Plan on July 2, 2020. The State is committed to completing its successful implementation of the Home and Community-Base Services (HCBS) Settings Final Rule. In reviewing the state's progress and recent correspondence from Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), we have decided to take advantage of the opportunity to request a corrective action plan (CAP) to extend our transition deadline and provide additional flexibility to the State. A CAP is requested for the following waivers:

- Adult Day Care (MO.1021)
- Aged & Disabled (MO.0026)
- AIDS Waiver (MO.0197)
- Community Support (MO.0404)
- Comprehensive (MO.0178)
- Partnership for Hope (MO.0841)
- Missouri Children With Developmental Disabilities (MO.4185)

A CAP is requested due to the need to have staff focus efforts on management of issues related to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency (PHE) and difficulties with staff turnover and filling vacancies related to the PHE, the State experienced delays full implementation of the statewide transition plan. The CAP is needed for the following:

- review and submit incomplete milestone updates/responses;
- review of provider remediation for adult day care providers;
- respond to any correspondence with CMS; and
- review of modification of rules/regulations/policies.

The State will continue to provide training, technical guidance and support to the provider agencies to ensure compliance in all areas of the HCBS Settings Rule.

The state expects all outstanding activities related to the HCBS Settings Rule to be completed by December 31, 2023.
